The Golden Bow is the symbol for breastfeeding promotion, protection, & support. One loop represents the mother. The other loop represents the child. The knot is the father, the family, & society. Without the family, & society. Without the knot there would be no bow. Without the support, breastfeeding cannot succeed.



The ribbon is symmetrical, telling us the mother & child are both vital to successful breastfeeding ~ neither is to the left or to the right, signifying neither is precedent, both are needed.

The color gold symbolizes that breastfeeding is the gold standard for infant feeding.

Origin of the gold bow being used is unknown.
